AMENDED CHARGE SHEET

That being registered in the Register of Veterinary Surgeons:

~~In or about September 2004,~~ On a day unknown between September 2004 and March 2005, while in practice at Swinfen Veterinary Centre, Old London Road, Swinfen, Lichfield and having prescribed and supplied Soloxine, the active ingredient of which is thyroxine, for your patient Past Experience, a racing greyhound:

You advised Mr Paul Meek, the National Greyhound Racing Club (NGRC) licensed trainer of Past Experience, that he could race Past Experience when under treatment with Soloxine (a substance prohibited by Rule 217 of the NGRC Rules as being a substance that could affect a greyhound's performance or wellbeing) when you knew or ought to have known that to race Past Experience in those circumstances would result in a breach of the NGRC Rules of Racing;

Past Experience was raced contrary to the Rules of Racing and following a NGRC stewards inquiry, you were severely reprimanded and fined £750 (as a licensed NGRC Track Veterinary Surgeon) and Mr Meek was reprimanded and fined £300 (as a NGRC licensed trainer).

And that in relation to the facts alleged, you have been guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.
