ADJOURNMENT

The Committee has considered carefully the submissions of Counsel and the advice of the Legal Assessor. It is prepared to adjourn until 10am on 10 November 2006 its consideration under Rule 18.2 as to whether to give its judgment forthwith or to postpone judgment for a period not exceeding two years on the following terms agreed by Counsel for the College and Mr Basha namely that:

1. The College initiate a RCVS Tier 2 full practice inspection of Animal Ark Veterinary Practice, Goodmayes, Essex, the report to be provided to the Committee on or before 4pm on 3 November 2006.
2. Mr Lyndon Basha prepare a detailed plan to address his clinical, medical, surgical and diagnostic shortcomings, the plan to be provided to the Committee on or before 4pm on 19 October 2006. For the avoidance of doubt the plan should include proposed attendance at structured and recognised CPD courses, particularly those offering 'hands-on' practical sessions. The proposals in the plan to be in addition to the 35 hour annual average CPD expected by the RCVS.
