JUDGMENT

The Committee has listened carefully to the mitigation by the Respondent's Counsel and the testimonials which have been produced.

The Committee wishes to make it clear that it expects all veterinary surgeons who are licensed by the NGRC or who are involved in regulated greyhound racing, to have read and fully understood the rules of the NGRC, particularly in relation to the administration of drugs and other substances, and apply them.

The Committee is mindful of the penalties already imposed by the NGRC Steward's Inquiry, and in view of the mitigation advanced on behalf of Mr Lesolle has no wish to impose any further penalty on him.

However, the Committee does expect Mr Lesolle to revisit and thoroughly familiarise himself with the NGRC rules and conduct his practice accordingly.
