AMENDED CHARGE SHEET

That being Registered in the Register of Veterinary Surgeons:-

1. On an unknown date or dates between 15 January 2006 and 23 January 2006 while you were employed as a locum veterinary surgeon by the People's Dispensary for Sick Animals in Plymouth you stole from your employers the following controlled drugs:
 - Vetergesic and/or
 - Midazolam (Hypnovel)

and that in relation to the facts alleged, you have been guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.

2. On an unknown date or dates between 4 February 2006 and 3 March 2006 while you were employed as a locum veterinary surgeon by the Hadrian Veterinary Group you stole from your employers the following controlled drugs:
 - Bupronorphine (Vetergesic/Veterol) and/or
 - Diamorphine and/or
 - Morphine and/or
 - Diazepam

and that in relation to the facts alleged, you have been guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.

3. On an unknown date or dates between 18 March 2006 and 23 April 2006 while you were employed as a locum veterinary surgeon by the Alder Veterinary Hospital you stole from your employers the following controlled drugs:
 - Pethidine and/or
 - Midazolam

and that in relation to the facts alleged, you have been guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.

4. On or about 10 January 2006 you obtained without proper authority for your own personal use from National Veterinary Services the following controlled drugs:
 - 2 packs each containing 10 Hypnovel ampoules 10mg/2ml;
 - 10 packs each containing 5 Vetergesic ampoules 1ml

and that in relation to the facts alleged, you have been guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.
