RCVS Compassion Award nomination form

Please note that any information supplied in this application will form the basis of a citation for the successful nominees to be read by the President of the RCVS at Royal College Day in July 2023.

The deadline for making a nomination is 5pm on Friday 27 January 2023.

Nominations for the RCVS Student Community Award can be made by anyone – they do not need to be an MRCVS or RVN – **although current RCVS Council and VN Council members are excluded.** Nominees for the award can be any student who is enrolled on an RCVS-approved veterinary or veterinary nursing course, or studying for a relevant postgraduate veterinary/veterinary nursing qualification.

The RCVS Compassion Award is a new award to be bestowed for the first time in 2021, to reflect the focus of the RCVS on compassion, as part of the 2020-2024 Strategic Plan.		
It will be awarded to a veterinary surgeon or veterinary nurse at any stage of their career who has demonstrated compassion towards fellow professionals and/or members of the animal-owning public. This may be as part of a one-off initiative or sustained over a longer period of time, but the individual needs to have made a significant impact and shown genuine compassion above and beyond what might have been expected of them as part of their day-to-day work.

Supporters' statements

Nomination applications require two supporting statements of **no more than 250 words** which may be from an MRCVS, RVN or layperson. At least one of these must be someone who is not a close working colleague of the person nominated, to demonstrate breadth of support. The supporting statements should be **no longer than 250 words** and should include:

•	The name of the nominee
•	The award/honour for which they are being proposed
•	Supporter's job title
•	Relationship to the nominee
•	Information about why they believe the nominee is deserving of the RCVS Compassion Award
•	Date
