Honorary Associateship nomination form

Please note that any information supplied in this application will form the basis of a citation for the successful nominees to be read by the President of the RCVS at Royal College Day in July 2023.

The deadline for making a nomination is 5pm on Friday 27 January 2023.

Nominations for Honorary Associateship can only be made by MsRCVS and RVNs, **excluding current members of RCVS Council** and VN Council. Nominees for the award should be laypeople who are not current MsRCVS or RVNs. Supporting statements can be supplied by non-veterinary professionals.

Relevant qualifications of nominee: these will be used on the certificate in the event that the nomination is successful.		
Honorary Associateship is awarded to non-veterinary laypeople in recognition of the special contribution they make to the veterinary sphere. Previous recipients have included scientists, lecturers, educationalists, charity-workers, journalists, farriers, farmers and those involved in the commercial field. In no more than 350 words please tell us why you think your nominee is deserving of an Honorary Associateship.		
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NOMINEE'S CAREER HISTORY: in no more than 250 words please give us an overview of your nominee's career and how it relates to the veterinary sphere, including any relevant voluntary or part-time work.
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Any other relevant information: in no more than 250 words please provide us with any further information you feel may support this application – this could include, for example, anecdotes about your interactions with the individual or information about their
nobbies, interests or personal life.

Supporters' statements

Nomination applications require two supporting statements of **no more than 250 words** which may be from an MRCVS, RVN or layperson. At least one of these must be someone who is not a close working colleague of the person nominated, to demonstrate breadth of support. The supporting statements should be **no longer than 250 words** and should include:

•	The name of the nominee
•	The award/honour for which they are being proposed
•	Supporter's job title
•	Relationship to the nominee
•	Information about why they believe the nominee is deserving of the Honorary Associateship
•	Date
