At least one of these must be someone who is not a close working colleague of the person nominated, to demonstrate breadth of support. The supporting statements should be **no longer than 250 words** and should include:

•	The name of the nominee
•	The award/honour for which they are being proposed
•	Supporter's job title
•	Relationship to the nominee
•	Information about why they believe the nominee is deserving of the Queen's Medal
•	Date
