Nominees must be RVNs, excluding current VN Council members. Supporting statements can be supplied by non-veterinary professionals.

•	Supporter's job title
•	Relationship to the nominee
•	Information about why they believe the nominee is deserving of the VN Golden Jubilee Award
•	Date
