Methodology




March 2015

An online public omnibus survey, designed to explore levels of trust in the veterinary profession. A total of 2,002 adults from across Great Britain participated in the survey, which was conducted by market research agency ICM Unlimited between 18 and 20 March 2015. The sample was weighted to be representative of the population of Great Britain.

May 2019

- Walnut Omnibus is a quantitative syndicated survey conducted twice a week. The survey is conducted online, interviewing a nationally-representative sample of 2,000 GB adults (aged 18+).
- ➤ The responding sample is weighted to the profile of the sample definition to provide a representative reporting sample. The nationally-representative profile is based on census data collected by the National Office for Statistics.




Service received

2019 SERVICE RECEIVED: Satisfaction high with their vet



80% satisfied or very satisfied. One of the professions with the highest number "very satisfied" (39%)


Q1. How satisfied are you with the service that you receive from each of the following professions that you use? Base: All who use this service (weighted)

COMPARISON 2015 vs 2019: Satisfaction with the service received from their vet remains high and unchanged in terms of % satisfied / very satisfied and also ranking. The level of dissatisfaction also remains similar





Q1. How satisfied are you with the service that you receive from each of the following professions that you use? Base: All who use this service (weighted)




Trust

2019 TRUST: There is a high level of trust in the veterinary profession



94% generally or completely trust the veterinary profession. One of the professions with the highest number who "completely trust" them (34%)

COMPARISON 2015 vs 2019: Trust in the veterinary profession remains high and unchanged between waves in terms of % trust and also ranking MG&A



Value for money

2019 VFM: The majority of animal owners (70%) feel vet fees are at least fair, with over a third (38%) feeling they are at least good value for money






Q3. If you are an animal owner, thinking in general about the fees charged by your veterinary practice, how do you rate their value for money?


COMPARISON 2015 vs 2019: The perception of value for money remains unchanged

SUMMARY

Summary: The veterinary profession has retained its strong position of providing a high level of satisfaction, being trusted and being perceived as at least good or excellent value for money by approximately a third



Level of satisfaction with veterinary services

- Remains high
 - 2019 80% satisfied / very satisfied
 - 2015 78% satisfied / very satisfied

Level of trust in the veterinary profession

- Remains very high
 - 2019 94% generally trust / completely trust
 - 2015 95% generally trust / completely trust

Value for money

- Remains high
 - 2019 32% good / excellent value for money
 - 2015 32% good / excellent value for money
