

Modular combinations for the designated certificate in Animal Welfare Science, Ethics and Law (AWSEL)

The following AWSEL modules are available, either as free-standing modules or as part of the Certificate in Advanced Veterinary Practice and the designated certificate in AWSEL.

Candidates will be expected to demonstrate a clear slant to AWSEL across all these modules (except for the Free Choice module).

Candidates who have achieved 20 credits from a combination of the A-Professional Key Skills module.1 (A-PKS.1) **AND** the B-Clinical Key Skills.0 (B-CKS.0) module may use these towards their designated certificate in place of the A-Foundations of Advanced Veterinary Practice (A-FAVP.1) module **AND** the "Free Choice" module.
