

MODULAR COMBINATIONS FOR THE DESIGNATED CERTIFICATE IN EQUINE BEHAVIOURAL MEDICINE

The following Equine Behavioural Medicine modules are available, either as free-standing modules or as part of the Certificate in Advanced Veterinary Practice and the designated certificate in Equine Behavioural Medicine.

All of the following modules are worth 10 credits or 100 notional study hours.

Free choice	The candidate may choose a B or C module from any discipline. Equitation Science B is recommended, or any C-Equine or C-AWSEL modules.	10 credits

Candidates who have achieved 20 credits from a combination of the A-Professional Key Skills module.1 (A-PKS.1) **AND** the B-Clinical Key Skills.0 (B-CKS.0) module may use these towards their designated certificate in place of the A-Foundations of Advanced Veterinary Practice (A-FAVP.1) module **AND** the “Free Choice” module.
