INQUIRY RE:

SUSAN CATHERINE MULVEY MRCVS

CHARGES

THAT, being registered in the Register of Veterinary Surgeons and whilst in practice at 16 Spinners Court, 55 West End, Witney, Oxfordshire OX28 1NH, you:

1. In relation to an English Cocker Spaniel named Henry belonging to LC and BC:

(A) Between 9 May 2018 and 30 October 2018, failed to provide Henry's clinical history to the Tremain Veterinary Group, despite requests for the same on the following dates:

- (i) 9 May 2018
- (ii) 10 May 2018
- (iii) 17 May 2018
- (iv) 22 August 2018
- (v) 28 August 2018; and/or

(B) Between 7 August 2018 and 30 October 2018, failed to communicate adequately or at all with LC and BC in relation to their requests for information regarding Henry, more particularly in relation to:

- (i) Clinical records for Henry; and/or
- (ii) Details of insurance claims made for Henry by you or your practice;

2. Between 4 January 2019 and 19 February 2019, failed to respond to reasonable requests from the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons, more particularly in relation to requests relating to:

- (i) Henry C;
- (ii) your Continuing Professional Development;
- (iii) your Professional Indemnity Insurance;

and/or in respect of 2 (iii):

- (iv) Between 9 May 2019 and 19 February 2019, failed to have in place any or any adequate Professional Indemnity Insurance or equivalent arrangements;

AND that in relation to the above, whether individually or in any combination, you are guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.
