VN GOLDEN JUBILEE AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Please note that any information supplied in this application will form the basis of a citation for the successful nominees to be read by the President of the RCVS at Royal College Day in July 2026.

The deadline for making a nomination is **5pm on Wednesday 7 January 2026**.

Nominations for the Golden Jubilee Award can only be made by MsRCVS or RVNs **excluding current members of RCVS Council and VN Council, and close relatives (including spouses) of the nominee**. Nominees must be RVNs, **excluding current VN Council members**. Supporting statements can be supplied by non-veterinary professionals.

PART ONE: NOMINEE INFORMATION

The VN Golden Jubilee Award was launched in 2011 to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the first veterinary nursing training course. The Award is for veterinary nurses who have had a sustained and distinguished career, who can demonstrate a leadership role within the profession and can act as an ambassador for the value of veterinary nurses and their work.
