

## Application for Temporary Registration Form

### UK Graduands

This form is for **students who have passed the final examinations** for a recognised veterinary degree awarded by a university in the United Kingdom and want to start practising veterinary surgery before the degree is formally conferred upon them. Temporary registration can allow them to practise, subject to certain conditions, pending graduation.

Temporary registration will only be granted if the pass list is published at least 15 days before the date of graduation.

**Please note: Temporary Registrants may not use the post-nominal MRCVS – they cannot sign prescriptions or certificates, or other documents that require the signature of an MRCVS.**

Please submit the temporary registration form as soon as possible or at least 14 working days before the date you intend to start work.

Please note you must have made an application for full registration and paid the registration fee prior to applying for temporary registration.

We will acknowledge your application within 3 working days, and you will receive confirmation of your entry to the Temporary List via email within 10 working days of the RCVS receiving your completed form.
