Nominations for the Impact Award can only be made by MsRCVS and RVNs, excluding current members of RCVS Council and VN Council, and close relatives (including spouses) of the nominee. Nominees for the award must be MsRCVS or RVNs or be part of a vet- or RVN-led team, excluding current RCVS Council and VN Council members. Supporting statements can be supplied by non-veterinary professionals.

This award is also open to self-nomination. If you are self-nominating, please be sure to complete this form in the third person using your own name and preferred pronouns in place of 'I' to avoid bias.
