

'UK Practising' Application Form

UK Practising is the category for any member who engages in any act of veterinary surgery or veterinary related activity in the United Kingdom. To change your Register category to 'UK Practising' please read the guidance notes and complete and sign below:

Guidance notes

The Regulations state that "practise or practising" means (whether or not for remuneration) undertaking acts of veterinary surgery as defined in section 27(1) of the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 or undertaking any activity which is, in the opinion of the Council of the RCVS, veterinary related. In the opinion of Council veterinary related activity includes a member who is professionally active, even if not involved in clinical work, e.g. members employed by government departments or agencies, in academia, at research councils, or in industry and commerce. In other words, "practising" is not limited to those in practice, but includes members using their professional qualification in any way.

If you have been listed as **Practising outside of the UK** for more than 12 months you may be asked to provide a Letter of Good Standing from your current registration authority (valid for 3 months after the date of issue), plus a certified translation if it is not issued in English.

If you have been listed as a **Non-practising** member then please state the reason, e.g. maternity leave, retirement, illness or injury, career break, non-veterinary employment, other (please specify in the box below). Please note if you have been off the Register for 12 months or longer, you may also be asked to provide evidence of good standing.

Your category of registration cannot unfortunately be changed until this form is completed, signed and returned. Your category will be changed from the date of receipt of the form if the change is to be made immediately. If the form is received ahead of the date when the change is to be made, the change of category will not be made until that date. We are very sorry but changes of category cannot be backdated.

A credit to your RCVS account may be due if a change of category is to be made between 1 April and 30 September and where the application has been received by 30 September. Any credit made to your RCVS account will be calculated from the date on which the change of category is made; it will be credited to your RCVS account and deducted from the next year's annual renewal fee.
