DAVID HURLEY MRCVS

CHARGES

THAT, being registered in the Register of Veterinary Surgeons and whilst in practice at Abbey Veterinary Centre, 2 Augusta Street, Grimsby, DN34 4TA ("the Practice"):

1. On 19 April 2022, when speaking with Person A in respect of Niffler, a pug who was admitted to the Practice that evening for overnight care:
 - (a) during a consultation at the Practice, you told Person A that Niffler would be kept monitored and under observation all night, or words to that effect.
 - (b) during a telephone call at around 22.04hrs, you told Person A that Niffler would be monitored and kept under observation throughout the night, or words to that effect.
2. Your conduct in relation to 1(a) and 1(b) above was:
 - (a) Misleading.
 - (b) Dishonest, in that you did not intend for Niffler to be monitored and/or observed throughout the night.

AND that in relation to the matters set out above, whether individually or in any combination, you are guilty of disgraceful conduct in a professional respect.
